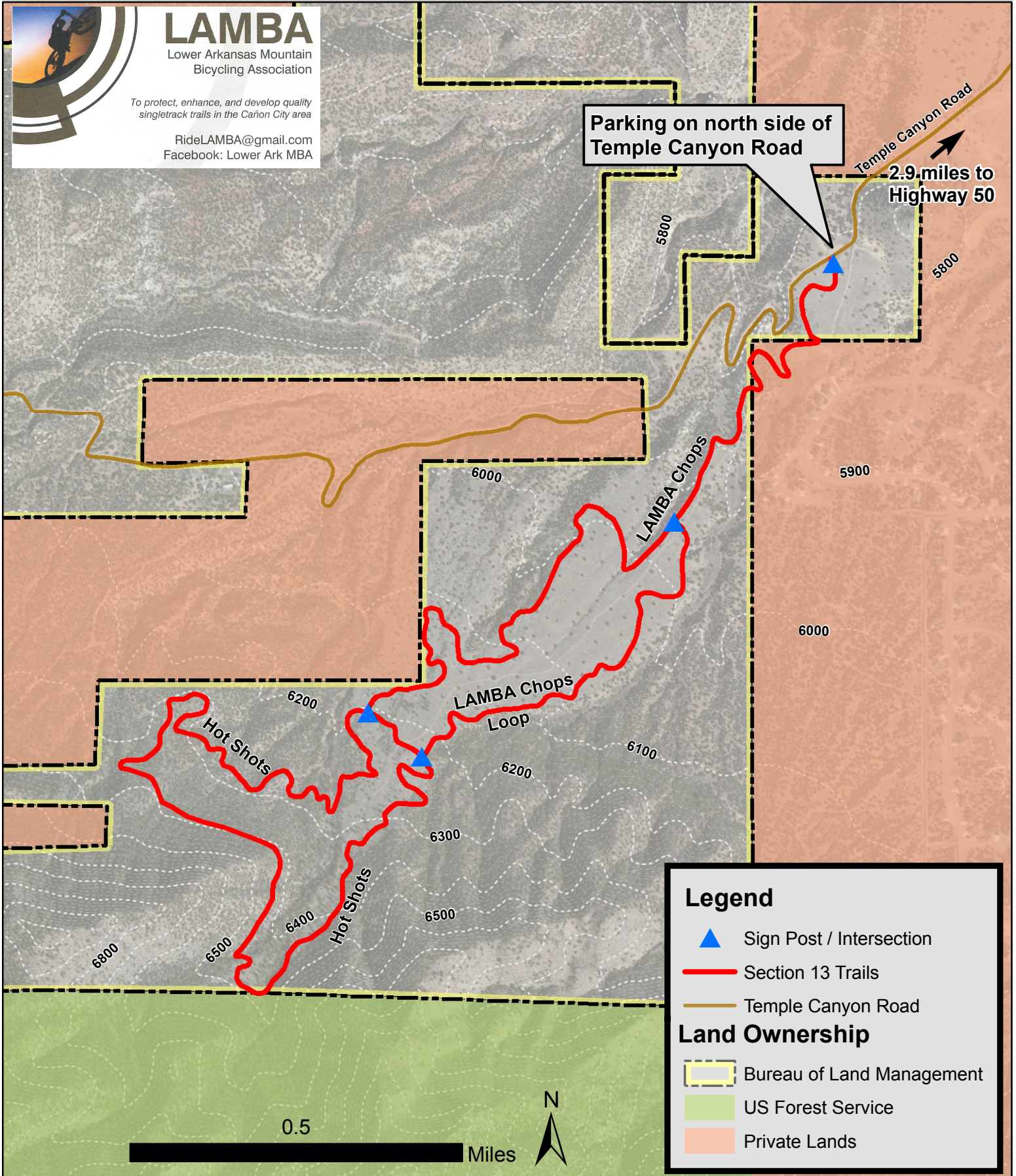

Section 13 Trails: LAMBA Chops & Hotshots

What is it:	A moderate singletrack trail through junipers and piñons at the base of the Wet Mountains. LAMBA Chops takes you through the lower loop, touring through more open terrain, while Hotshots offers a slightly more technical and steep experience through denser trees.
Distance:	6 miles total for a round-trip (double up or ride in reverse for more!)
Climbing:	700' to the top of Hotshots
Who:	Intermediate/Novice singletrack enthusiasts
Season:	Best during spring and fall; ride-able in winter when dry; summer can be hot and dry – bring lots of water!
Why it's awesome:	Close to town with great views of Cañon City & Pikes Peak as you ride alongside deer, wild turkeys, and other native wildlife

Directions to Trailhead:

From the west end of Cañon City on Highway 50:

- Turn south on First Street, continue for 1 mile
- Turn west (right) on Temple Canyon Road (CR 3), continue for 1.9 miles
(If you start to go downhill on Temple Canyon Road, you have gone too far.)
- Park head-in in the small parking area on the north side (right) of Temple Canyon Road (CR 3)
- Access trails through fence opening on south side of Temple Canyon Road

Ethics & Friendly Reminders:

- Keep singletrack single!
 - When yielding, don't ride off trail: stop and step
 - Ride the line: don't ride around obstacles
 - Ride when the trail is dry and stay off when wet
 - Ride, don't slide: stay in control of your bike – skidding destroys the trail surface and leads to erosion
- Expect and respect other trail users
- Uphill travel has the right-of-way
- Bicycles yield to hikers and equestrian users
- Know your bike and stay in control at all times
- Be awesome: educate others and set a positive example
